

Finding a Hotel for London Cyclists

Cycling in London is a fantastic way to experience one of the world's most vibrant and architecturally interesting cities.

But there is more to a cycling holiday than merely jumping on a bike and heading into the urban sprawl. There is plenty of planning to do, to make sure your trip goes smoothly and as enjoyably as possible.

If you're visiting from outside London, you may well want to find a London hotel to rest your weary legs at the end of a hard day's cycling. Luckily, there is an array of bike-friendly London hotels for you to choose from.

When booking a London hotel, cyclists should consider a number of factors. Is there a lockable covered shed for cycle storage? Once your bike is out of sight, you will want to be content in the knowledge that it is safely stored and protected against theft or damage.

Another important issue is the proximity of a bike repair shop. Ideally you'll want to choose a hotel within walking distance of one, otherwise you face the prospect of having to transport your bike to the store, or pay for a collection.

Furthermore, all that cycling is going to mean at least one change of clothes a day. You'll want to be in a hotel with washing facilities, and also a separate drying area for outdoor clothing and shoes.

Below is a selection of bike-friendly hotels in London that meet the above criteria.

The 3-star [George Hotel London](#) is positioned close to Regent's Park, one of the finest parks in London. The nearest bike repair store is The Cycle Centre, which is located on New Cavendish Street, about a 20 minute walk from the hotel.

The 3-star Thistle Bloomsbury Park Hotel is located in Holborn, one of the city's most historically interesting business and commercial districts. There is a Bikefix repair shop on Conduit Street, around a 15 minute walk from the hotel.

The 4-star [Apex City of London Hotel](#) is situated close to the Tower of London, one of the city's most famous and historical attractions. A 15 minute walk away is Evans Cycles, which can be found on Cullum Street.
